I _____ (Mare Owner), hereby agree on _____ (Date) to contract with James and Victoria Ellet (Stallion Owner) to breed the following mare, _____ (Mare Name) _____ (Reg. #) to Dual Equis (AQHA 5864160) for the 2025 breeding season (February 15th – July 1st, and subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. Fees: The following fees designate the stallion service fee, booking fee,

A. The Stallion Service Fee is \$1,100.00 and is **non-transferable. This fee only applies to the calendar year booked.**

B. Early Booking Fee: The early booking fee is **only applicable to the first 10 mares booked** and is \$850.00 with non-refundable deposit of \$400 due upon signing and return of contract. The remaining balance of \$450 will be due before ordering semen in 2025. The early booking fees do not include chute or shipping fees.

C. Booking Fee: A \$500.00 Non-Refundable booking fee shall accompany the signed and returned contract and will be applied to the stallion service fee. The remaining balance of the stallion service fee in the amount of \$600 will become due before ordering semen. Payment options include check, Zelle, Venmo, or a Credit Card. A 3% convenience fee will apply to all credit card transactions.

D. Shipping & Collection Fee: Shipping and collection is \$430 and payable directly to Youngblood Equine. **The shipping and collection fee must be paid prior to receiving any semen, or on-site breeding services.** Please expect to receive one dose of semen per shipment. Two doses will only be sent upon availability.

E. Rebreed Fees, Donated Breedings, and Futurity Donation Breedings : Rebreed fees are \$500.00 and are subject to a \$275.00 collection/lab fee plus shipping expenses. All Donated breedings and futurity donation breedings are subject to a \$275.00 collection/lab fee, plus shipping expenses.

F. Shipped Semen Contract with Youngblood Equine: Shipped semen contracts must be filled out prior to semen being shipped. Stallion service fee must be paid in full. Please refer to the Youngblood Equine Veterinary Services Shipped Semen Contract.

2. Collection Days and Semen Ordering: Collection days are MONDAYS, WEDNESDAYS, AND FRIDAYS. Please note FedEx services are unavailable on Memorial Day. Please plan accordingly. All calls for semen **MUST BE RECEIVED BY 6PM THE DAY PRIOR TO COLLECTION.** To order semen, please call the office at (254) 205-7438. Your order will be considered confirmed unless you call to cancel no later than 9am Central Time the morning of collection. Any cancellations received after the cutoff time will incur a \$150 cancellation charge to cover supplies and time used/spent.

3. Shipping Method: All semen is shipped via FedEx Priority Overnight or FedEx First Priority Overnight. ***If mare owner chooses FedEx First Priority Overnight; please note an additional \$200 charge will be incurred for the added shipping expense.***

4. On-Site Breeding: On-Site Breeding has **LIMITED AVAILABILITY.** Please contact Youngblood Equine at (254) 204-7438 to confirm availability and to schedule your mare drop off at least 14 days in advance. Space is limited and therefore, not guaranteed. If there is no availability, we can refer you to other local breeding facilities.

5. Pregnancy Status Notification: It is the Mare Owner's responsibility to notify Victoria Ellet of pregnancy status within 30 days of insemination. Failure to contact Victoria Ellet by August 1st will result in a \$50 late fee to add the mare to the Stallion Breeding Report.

6. Breeder's Certificate: To obtain a Breeder's Certificate you must notify Victoria Ellet of the birth of the foal. This certificate will not be issued or released until the account has been paid in full.

7. Embryo Transfers: Mare Owner agrees to notify Youngblood Equine that this is an embryo transfer mare. In the event of multiple embryos from a single flush, Mare Owner agrees to notify Youngblood Equine once the additional recipient mare(s) have been confirmed in foal with a heartbeat present. The Mare Owner must then pay a Stallion Service Fee in the amount of \$1,100.00 for each additional live foal. The additional Stallion Service Fee(s) is due upon the additional foal(s) standing and nursing. Additional Breeder's Certificates will be issued upon receipt of necessary Stallion Service Fee(s).

8. Live Foal Guarantee: Live foal means the foal shall stand and nurse without assistance. It is understood that if the mare proves barren, aborts her foal, or if the foal is stillborn, a return service breeding will be guaranteed the following season only at Youngblood Equine

Veterinary Services, providing that written notification is received within 7 days of the occurrence. Third year rebreeds are at the discretion of the Stallion Owner. A live foal guarantee will apply to those mares that are certified in foal by a licensed veterinarian. Confirmation must be sent to Victoria Ellet to guarantee a rebreed. Confirmation should be in the form of a written letter from an attending licensed veterinarian. Stallion Owner does not make any warranty or representation as to the quality of conformation of the foal, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, or that the foal will be free of any infirmity, conformation defect, disease, or inherited trait.

9. Rebreeds: If the mare does not produce a live foal the first breeding season, the mare owner is entitled to a rebreed the following season. Mare owners will be subject to an additional chute fee, plus any attending veterinarian fees. If the Mare Owner fails to return the mare for breeding the following year, all fees paid shall be forfeited, the right to rebreed is canceled, and the Stallion Owner is released from all further obligation of the contract, unless otherwise agreed to in writing and signed by all parties. All third year rebreeds are at the sole discretion of the Stallion Owner. Rebreed Fee is \$500.00.

10. Assignment: This contract is a binding agreement between Victoria and James Ellet (Stallion Owner) and the Mare Owner. This agreement is non-transferable and non-assignable, unless otherwise agreed to in writing, and signed by all parties. Any transferred breedings will incur an additional Chute Fee and will require completed paperwork by the new contract holder.

11. Mare's Requirements: Mare owner agrees that the mare presented for breeding will be in good health and in sound breeding condition. Any mare certified by the attending veterinarian to not be in sound breeding condition shall not be bred and a different mare may be substituted at no additional charge.

12. Social Media Agreement: The Mare Owner agrees that nothing shall be posted or shared via social media, other digital marketing formats, E-mail blasts, newsletters, blog posts, or digital or print articles that could be negatively construed regarding Youngblood Equine Veterinary Services, Victoria and James Ellet (Stallion Owner), nor any of its employees, associates, or affiliates. Failure to do so may result in legal action regarding the content and damages associated from such action. Furthermore, Victoria Ellet reserves the right to void this contract in the event this Agreement is breached. Any offending Mare Owner shall immediately forfeit any fees, payments, or right to a rebreed regardless of pregnancy status.

13. Stallion Obligation: Should the above-named stallion die or become unfit for service for any reason, then this contract shall become null and void and both parties are relieved

of any further obligation hereunder. Any monies paid by the Mare Owner toward the Stallion Fee, shall be refunded at the sole discretion of the Stallion Owner.

14. Enforceability: When the Mare Owner signs and returns this contract to the Breeder it becomes a valid and binding contract upon both parties. All unpaid expenses will be paid upon receipt of an invoice or when the mare leaves the facility, whichever is first. The mare and foal (if applicable) shall be released only upon payment in full of all outstanding balances, including those of the attending veterinarian. Monthly statements shall be mailed for services herein provided. Such statements shall be due and payable upon presentation. Statements not paid within 30 days will be subject to a finance charge of 2% per month or the maximum rate allowed by law.

15. Governance: This contract will be governed by the laws of the State of Texas. It is understood that Youngblood Equine Veterinary Services, its owners, employees, and guests shall not be liable for any injury, escape, disability, act of God or death of any horse on its premises. The parties hereby specifically agree that this Agreement shall be construed, governed, and interpreted by and in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Texas.
